OVERVIEW AND DISCLAIMER

Our PRRP program is designed to give players an opportunity to help our league grow, run efficiently and for players to make extra income while playing. If you're interested in an opportunity, please email your name, team, and positions applying for to Jerry Fairley at southernshoresbaseball@gmail.com. If you would like to include a resume with your information that pertains to the position applying for it is recommended but not mandatory.

JOB DESCRIPTIONS

- **Umpiring:** We have tested having players umpire games in our Spring Showcase league and it worked out great! The umpires have not affected the outcome of any games and, players were able to make money towards the costs associated in our league. Some players were even able to make more than they paid out. If you have previous umpiring experience and/or are certified, you will be on our preferred umpire list. However, we can train those who aren't experienced. The pay is \$50 per game in the field and \$60 per game behind the plate.
- **Team Transporters :** If you have a reliable vehicle, a valid Driver's License, and valid insurance you can apply to be a team transporter. You will be asked to provide the make, model, and year of your vehicle and the amount of players it can transport. You will be paid \$12.50 an hour to transport players to and from practices and games. You will only be paid for the driving distance to and from the field not the time in between games.
- **Scorekeepers:** If you are interested in keeping stats for another team in our league, you will be assigned to work up to two games per day. The rate of pay is \$12.50 an hour and you will be paid the duration of the game plus an extra half hour to enter stats into our stat hosting website. Prior bookkeeping experience is preferred but we can train you to keep the book. This position may also include playing walk up music and announcing batter names.
- **Practice Assistants:** If you are able to throw quality BP, hit fungos for infield/OF, and coach bases then you can apply to be a practice assistant. We prefer PO's for this position but positional players will be considered as well. The pay is \$12.50 an hour and the shift will last one hour per practice and the duration of the game you are assigned to work.
- **Recruiting:** Every player that you recruit for SSBL. You will be paid 5% of registration fees for direct referrals. You can opt to be paid in \$50 increments or let it accrue until the last calendar day of our season on 8/31/21. On 8/31/21, the full balance will be paid out to you no matter how much it is. You can also choose to have it applied to the next year's fees as well.
- **Fundraising:** Our team apparel stores will be open within the next few weeks. If a sale is made to support the team from yourself, your family, or friends you will get a specific amount per item sold. This will be credited to your PRRP account and you can opt to be paid in \$50 increments or let it accrue until the last calendar day of our season on 8/31/21. On 8/31/21, the full balance will be paid out to you no matter how much it is. You can also choose to have it applied to the next year's fees as well.

CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Certain positions may require a uniform to work.
2. Showing up late may result in reduction of pay, being sent home from your shift, and up to be taken off of future shifts
3. No calls, no shows will likely result in all future shifts being removed unless in the case of emergency
4. Professionalism is of the utmost importance. If you are not conducting yourself in a manner that is deemed professional by the administrators of SSBL then you will be removed from your shifts
5. If you show up to work and aren't prepared to work you will not be compensated. This includes not having the proper uniform, equipment, or being able to execute the duties of the job description scheduled for.

OTHER INDIRECT REVENUE OPPORTUNITIES

1. For players with cars, driving services like Grub Hub, Postmates, or UberEats may be a good way to make additional income when you are in town.
2. Most markets have plasma donation centers that will pay for donated plasma some up to \$125 dollars per week. This may be an option for those who are healthy enough and willing to donate plasma up to twice a week for an estimated hour and 30 minutes per visit.
3. Some players have transferred their job to our area for the duration of the season. Jobs such as Olive Garden, Target, Advance Auto, Walmart, Fed Ex and others have done a great job working with our players allowing them to play and work at the same time.
4. Employers such as McDonalds and Sheetz in most of our markets are constantly looking for third shift employees. We can give you the contact information after being assigned to your team to go through the employment process prior to arriving. This has worked for some players already.
